**DR. RAFAEL ROSADO
FALLBROOK FAMILY CLINIC**



Dr. Rafael Rosado went to school at the University of Puerto Rico, where he earned a Medical Doctorate Degree. Dr. Rosado practiced in Arizona before moving to Fallbrook to be closer to family. Dr. Rosado currently is a General Practitioner at the Fallbrook Family Clinic on Alvarado. Dr. Rosado currently sits on the Board of Directors for the Foundation for Senior Care; Dr. Rosado is the Physician Liaison for the Foundation as he focuses on building the Foundation’s three core programs: The Care Van, the Senior Care Advocate, and the Senior Day Care Center.

Dr. Rafael Rosado talked to the club today about general health. The Doctor covered how to choose a family physician, and explained what a family physician does. The Doctor gave members a checklist that covered procedures and routine check ups that are suppose to be done annually. Dr. Rosado explained that early detection is key in trying to treat almost all diseases and conditions.

Dr. Rosado then answered many questions the club had. Questions ranged from medications being affected by the consumption of grapefruit juice to treatments for gout.
